Introductions:

<u>7:20 p.m. – 7:25 p.m.</u> – Mark introduced the board and then we went around the room and introduced our selves.

<u>7:25-7:50</u>-Mark announced that the dinner and desserts were for everyone and encouraged all the guests to have some. Dinner was potluck style, homemade chili, appetizers, sandwiches, devilled eggs, cookies, salad, etc. with beverages and table settings provided by Bandon Heritage Place.

Minutes:

Guerin Memorial Essay Contest Winners:

8:05-8:20 – Caley Sowers introduced Anne Guerin as the daughter of Tom and Dorothy Guerin. This was the 31st anniversary of the Essay Memorial Contest. 1st place winner was Caitlin Ford, she read her essay; "How Farming, Ranching, and Timber Land Management Practices Have Changed Over the last 100 Years to Protect the Environment and Water Quality in Oregon and Coos County," received \$150.00 check, a certificate, and a plaque with her name on it to be displayed at Coquille Valley High School for

the next year. Second place winner Nicole Fossum (not present), received \$125.00 check and a certificate. Third place winner Marissa Gouvea, also from Coquille High School, received \$100.00 check and a certificate and read her essay titled "Conservation Practices Used by Landowners in Coos County to Protect Soil and Decrease Erosion."

Cooperator of the year:

8:20-8:35- This year's cooperator of the year was Keith Baker who was in attendance with his wife, Jamie Baker. They are from Broadbent and had completed a very interesting culvert replacement and off-channel watering project. The first part of the project removed an old school bus which had been buried and used as a culvert, but was failing and causing a sinkhole in the road above it. The second part involved the placement of two large concrete off-channel watering troughs. Caley did a slideshow presentation which chronicled the project from beginning to end and presented Keith and Jamie Baker with an award plaque.

Guest Speaker:

8:35-9:05- Caley introduced Woody Lane, PhD, owner and operator of Lane Livestock Services. Woody Lane is a livestock nutritionist and forage specialist from Roseburg, OR. He gave a 30 minute PowerPoint presentation on "A South Coast Ranch Study on N-Fertilizers: Water Quality, Forage Yields, & Nutritional Value" and provided a print version of the study findings as well.
